

LIBRARY


The School has a huge collection of subject specific, informative and story books for children to help them develop ideas, upgrade their knowledge and to perform well in examination.



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE STUDENTS:

- · Every student must carry his/her diary and identity card to school each day.
- All students should come to the school regularly and punctually.
- No child will be allowed to leave the school premises once he/she has come to school, in case any student required
- leaving the school premises during the school hours, the parents are requested to submit an application to the Principal.
- Application for leave should be entered in the diary itself.
- The student will come to the school in prescribed neat & well ironed uniform.
- They will bring the books according to the time table to the school.
- The students have to do the home work given in each subject Guardians are requested to sign the diary daily after checking it.
- No student should damage any school furniture, write or draw anything on walls, recovery for any damage will be made from the student concerned.
- Students should bring test books or Library books. (No other reading material).
- · Lending or borrowing of money or other articles is prohibited.
- The school provides the necessary material/equipment for sports activity during the games period. Student are not allowed to bring their own balls, bats, etc. to school
- · They will actively participate in all games, sports, and athletes, cultural and literary activities.
- It is imperatives for students to activity participate in different co-curricular and & extracurricular activities organized by the
- · school.
- · The school reserves the right to suspend a student if his/her conduct is found to be unsatisfactory.
- · No student shall indulge in any of the following practice:
- · Spitting in or near the school property
- · Disfiguring or damaging school property
- · Rude behavior and use od abusive language.
- · Use of violence in any form.

No self-driven vehicle is allowed to the students. They can come only by bicycle, if they are not found using self-driven vehicle to school. Strict action will be taken by the school. To ensure safety of their bicycle, students are advised to lock their bicycle and keep them at their allotted place.



ATTENDANCES AND LEAVE RULES:

- Attendance is compulsory on the first and the last working day of every term.
- 80% attendance is compulsory to appear in the terminal examination.
- Students who have been sick should bring a medical certificate from their doctor on joining the school.
- Parents should fill up "Record for Not Attendance" for each day the students is absent, from school stating the reasons for absence.
- No one who has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without a letter from the
 parent addresses to the Class Teacher, Stating the reasons for the absence.
- Leave for going out of station should be approved by the principal to proceeding on leave.
- In case of an emergency, parents will be informed and they will have to report to the principal. They are
 not allowed to go to the class directly.

WITHDRAWALS:

A Student can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds:

- · Indiscipline
- · Unsatisfactory progress in academics
- · Irregularity in the School
- · Non Payment of fees
- · Failing twice in the same class

All dues have to be cleared before a Transfer Certificate is issued. Tuition fee for the full session during which a student is Withdrawn shall have to be paid on Withdrawal of students School Uniform.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT:

Availability of Transport Facility

- School provides conveyance facility for the students on the request of the parents.
- Conveyance fee is charged with monthly fee for twelve months.
- In case a guardian withdraws his/her ward's conveyance facility, a moth s notice is essential otherwise one
 month's fee will be charged in lieu thereof.
- In case the school Bus does reach in time due to mechanical breakdown or due the illness of the driver, guardians are requested to make their own arrangements. However, the school does their best to provide an alternative service.

RECOMMEDATION TO THE PARENT/GUARDIANS:

- · Parents are requested to pay school fees in time.
- They are requested to provide uniform, books and stationary as prescribed by the school to their wards.
- · Parents should encourage wards to maintain regular and punctual attendance in the School.
- * Parents are requested to attend PTM and note the progress of their wards in studies and their behavior in school.
- Parents must sign the Progress Reports of their ward and take suitable action to remove deficiency if any.
- Attending the morning school assembly is compulsory for all students at least 5 minutes before the school commences.
- Parents must check that there ward is keeping cleanliness and neatness in his/her personal habit, uniform, text books, exercise books etc.
- Parents are requested to see that their wards complete the homework daily which is noted in the diary.
- The name, class and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on all the belongings of the student. The school
 accepts no responsibility whatsoever for losses of valuable brought to school.
- Guardians of girls are advised not to allow their wards to wear any jewelley. Besides their nails should be trimed properly.
- In case of any infectious disease in your home, please report the fact and do not sent your ward to class till the
 infectious period is over.
- Guardians are not allowed to meet teachers during school hours without the permission of the principal, alternatively they can seek prior appointment from the teacher concerned through the school diary.
- Guardians must intimate the school about any change in their address at the earliest in order to communicate to them in urgent matters in respect of their children.
- · Giving tip to the employee of the school will be seriously viewed.
- Parents cooperation is required to ensure overall development of their child.
